In addition, he serves on the Board and Executive Committee of the Alliance of Independent Academic Medical Centers and is a member of the Association of American Medical Colleges. In June 2010, Mr. Dadlez was confirmed as Chairman of the Connecticut Hospital Association Board.

In July 2009, Connecticut Governor M. Jodi Rell appointed Mr. Dadlez to her Connecticut Healthcare Reform Advisory Board. He is a member of the Governor's Prevention Partnership, and he served on the Governor's Council on Economic Competitiveness and Technology. He is a member of The Clarion Group Advisory Board and is a Board member of MetroHartford Alliance, chairing its Diversity and Inclusion Committee. He served on the Mayor's Healthy Communities Initiative and the Committee to End Chronic Homelessness.
